A NOTE FROM GARY...

Jesus said, "Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; he who seeks finds; and to him who knocks, the door will be opened." (Matthew 7:7-8) What marvelous possibilities God has in store for us-if we dare believe. Jesus said "I tell you the truth, if anyone says to this mountain, "Go, throw yourself into the sea," and does not doubt in his heart but believes that what he says will happen, it will be done for him. Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours." (Mark 11:23-24)

The "receiving" must be done as a little child (Luke 18:17). Children who are loved have confidence in the word of their father. Children naturally trust and expect father to keep his word. It's no big deal-they just count on the father's care.

I remember so well the evening Robin ran downstairs to kiss some visiting relatives good night.

"Now be sure to say your prayers," her grandmother admonished. "I will," Robin promised solemnly. Then, turning to the guests, she asked with innocent yet total assurance, "Anybody need anything?"

May the Lord restore in us that childlike heart, that we might come to Him with directness and simplicity and trust. Then we will receive and our joy will be made full-just as He intended.
