## A NOTE FROM GARY...

To be in Christ is to live an abundant, full life. It is to experience the real thing. Being in Christ will take us into dimensions of life that can only be lived with commitment and faithfulness. As it says in the Scriptures- "This is how we know we are in him: Whoever claims to live in Him must walk as Jesus did." (1 John 2:6) To live Christ's way requires us to "know and rely on the love God has for us. God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in him." (1 John 4:16)

That way of life was illustrated by Francis of Assisi (1182-1226). He became renowned for his selfless love of all God's creatures. The Lord transformed Francis from a rich, carousing, adventure seeking playboy (and later, soldier), to a man who renounced his wealth and totally dedicated himself to loving Jesus. Late in his life he tried to stop one of the crusades. Francis preached Christ's love to the Christian army, then visited the Moslem ruler and preached to him. He risked his life in that failed attempt to bring peace.

Francis left us a prayer that we might offer to God-offering ourselves to the Lord in true selfless service. May God answer this prayer as it comes from each of our hearts, that we might live a life of Christlike love. Francis prayed:

Lord,

Make me an instrument of Your peace.  
Where there is hatred, let me sow love;  
Where there is injury, pardon;  
Where there is doubt, faith;  
Where there is despair, hope;  
Where there is darkness, light, and  
Where there is sadness, joy.

O Divine Master,

Grant that I may not so much  
seek to be consoled as to console;  
To be understood as to understand;  
To be loved as to love;  
For it is in giving that we receive;  
It is in pardoning that we are pardoned;  
And it is in dying, that we born to  
eternal life.
