Pastor Lloyd Ogilvie told about calling a friend with a disappointing report on a project. "I'm afraid I have some bad news for you," Ogilvie said.

"Thank God!" the friend responded immediately.

"What?" Ogilvie said astounded.

"Well," the friend said thoughtfully, "I want what God wants. If the report is less than what I hoped then I am thankful because to have something he has not willed would not be best for me. To have what He wills is joy; to have something He has not willed is spiritual suicide. Give me the report and let's move on from here. We've got to be ready to play the ball where it is on the field."

How do you react to the day to day ups and downs? Ogilvie went on to suggest: "Make this a seven day experiment. Resolve to rejoice! Not regardless of what comes your way, but because of it. There's blessing waiting, wrapped up in each questionable eventuality. Expect it. Look for it. Thank God for it in advance. You will note the change that happens in your attitudes."

Such a way of life expresses deep trust in God. That confidence is taught in Scripture: "And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose." (Romans 8:28) Through all the events of our lives, God is actively

reshaping our lives into the likeness of Jesus. When we truly know that, then we can live with courage and hope!
