A NOTE FROM GARY...

"Brothers, I could not address you as spiritual but as worldly-mere infants in Christ. I gave you milk, not solid food, for you were not yet ready for it. Indeed, you are still not ready. You are still worldly. For since there is jealousy and quarreling among you, are you not worldly? Are you not acting like mere men?" (1 Corinthians 3:1-3) There comes a time when we need to grow up-to mature in our response to the Lord. It's not a shameful thing to have been an infant, but we don't want to get stuck at that place in life.

In one Peanuts cartoon strip, we see little Sally crawling on the floor and Linus says to Lucy, "How long do you think it will be before Sally starts to walk?" Lucy's reply is quick and snappy: "Good Grief! What's the hurry? Let her crawl around for a while! Don't rush her! ...She's got all the time in the world..Once you stand up and start to walk, you're committed for life."

But it is necessary to get on with it. The urgency of Christ's call to us and the need for decision and commitment says NOW. The time comes for taking risks-perhaps starting with baby steps. Then before you know it you're walking and running. Who knows where that will take us? But Lucy was right-it's risky business and you can't go back.

That's how it is with Jesus. He called us to join Him in His divine crusade for the redemption of the world. When he commanded people to follow Him, they arose from their knees, and their decisions to follow had lifetime reverberations...even unto death!

The disciples that stood up for Christ in the early church received a power that was utterly invincible. That same power is available today. The only question is, "Do we want it?" We can go beyond milk, to more solid food-as the Lord confronts and teaches us by His dynamic and living Word.

Even a crawling child takes risks, however apprehensive the parents are. But as we grow up spiritually, we will be ready to take bigger risks-for the glory of God and enhancement of His kingdom. He will always be there-encouraging us, pleased with us, and always urging us on. Let's grow up and enjoy all the new opportunities that God opens up to us.
