## A NOTE FROM GARY...

### Happy Father's Day!

Fathers shape the lives of their children, for better or worse. How thankful we are for responsible, loving fathers who were always there for us. Their care not only nurtured us, but gave us an insight into the love of our Heavenly Father.

God is always there, just as it is true of the best earthly father we can imagine. Children are particularly able to live and take risks when they know their father is there to love them and look out for them.

A story came out of the World War II about a father and his young daughter. Their English village was being bombed by the Germans. One night they rushed to a large crater that had been formed by an earlier night of bombing. In the half light caused by fires and explosions, the father clambered down into the hole. Hidden at the bottom on the hole by darkness, he told his daughter to leap down to him-"I'll catch you," he said. But she was afraid, replying to him, "But I can't see you." "That doesn't matter," her father said, "I can see you." And she jumped to safety in his arms.

That's what our Heavenly Father is like. He is the One we can trust like little children. He is there, waiting for us, loving us, never giving up, always drawing us toward Him-even going to the cross for us.

Isn't it astonishing? "How great is the love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are!" (I John 3:1) He loves us and enfolds us in His constant care. "Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows." (James 1:17)
